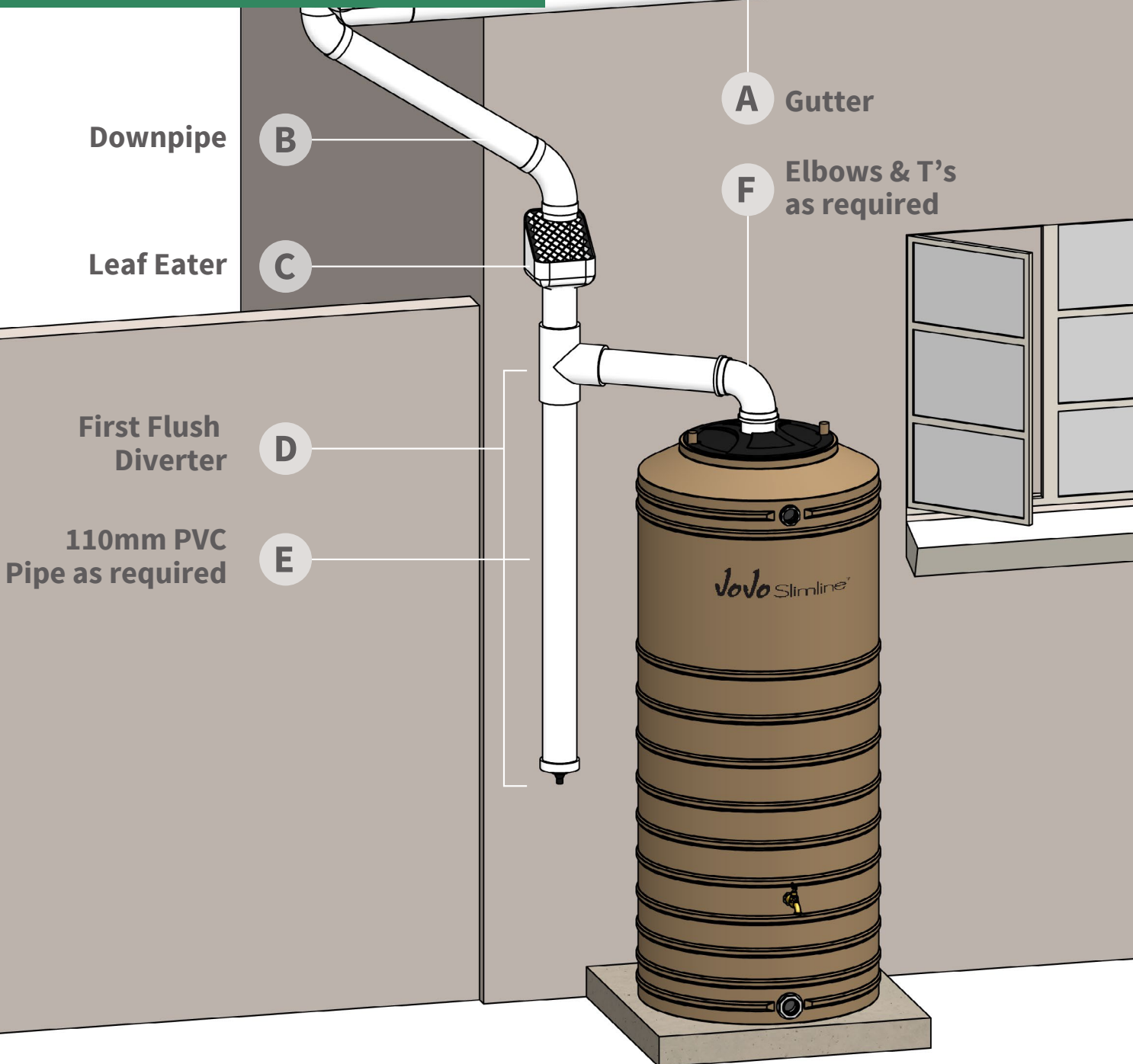


How to connect a gutter to your tank

Basic installation using a leaf eater & first flush diverter to harvest rainwater

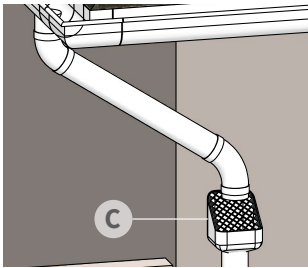
COMPONENTS REQUIRED



How to connect a gutter to your tank

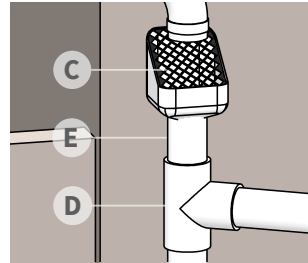
Basic installation using a leaf eater & first flush diverter to harvest rainwater

ASSEMBLY



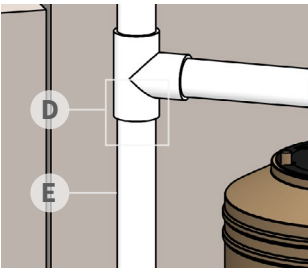
01

Route existing downpipe to leaf eater (C). Downpipe ends approximately 35mm above leaf eater.



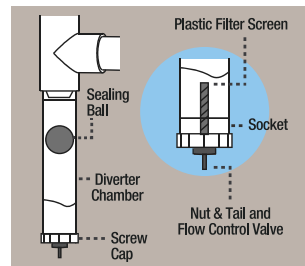

Fit leaf eater (C) to 110mm PVC pipe (E) and route into T part of (D) first flush diverter (length will vary based on preference).



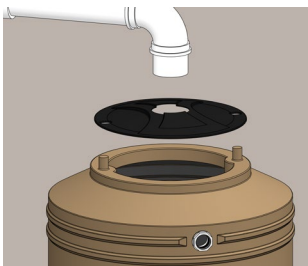

Fit (E) 110mm PVC pipe to T part of the first flush diverter (D) where the ball seat will be placed.



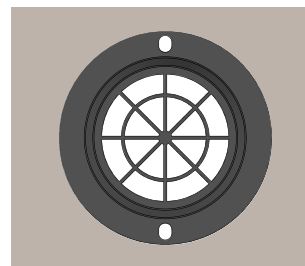

Fit screw cap (with seal & ball placed inside) to bottom of 110mm PVC pipe (E).

Cut a hole of 110.5mm in the middle of the lid and fit the pipe through the hole.



Tip

Fit stainless steel mesh (480mm filter screen) beneath the lid to keep out smaller debris and insects.
