

Maintaining Your Chemical Toilet

Pit toilets require very little upkeep once installed, but following proper maintenance and safe emptying guidelines is essential for long-term functionality and hygiene. We recommend the following:

1. Prepare the drum correctly

Always add the recommended amount of water and chemical solution before first use. This ensures proper odour control and helps break down waste effectively.

2. Service regularly based on usage

High-traffic sites may need more frequent waste removal. Sticking to a schedule prevents overfilling, keeps the unit hygienic, and extends its lifespan.

3. Keep the toilet clean inside and out

Wipe surfaces daily with a mild disinfectant, paying attention to the seat, handle points, and floor area. Cleanliness improves user comfort and prevents bacterial buildup.

4. Use only approved chemicals

Avoid harsh or incompatible products. Proper toilet chemicals are designed to break down waste, reduce odours, and protect the drum material.

5. Store drums properly when not in use

Rinse thoroughly, allow to dry, and store with lids on in a shaded area to prevent UV damage and contamination.
