

Is Your Water Safe to Drink?

The JoJo Test Kits test several things that can tell you more about the quality of your water. While all the results are important, the checks below are the key ones to look at when it comes to whether your water is safe to drink.

Use the table below as a quick guide to identify results that may require further attention.

BACTERIA TEST	SAFE RANGE	NOT SAFE
Petrifilm: E. coli	No blue spots	1 or more blue spots
Petrifilm: Coliform	1 red spot or less	2 or more red spots
iWaterScan	Water turns yellow	Water turns black

COMPLETE TEST	SAFE RANGE	NOT SAFE
Petrifilm: E. coli	No blue spots	1 or more blue spots
Petrifilm: Coliform	1 red spot or less	2 or more red spots
iWaterScan	Water turns yellow	Water turns black
Nitrite	0 to 1 ppm	More than 1 ppm
Nitrate	0 to 10 ppm	More than 20 ppm
Phosphate	0 to 10 ppm	25 ppm and more
pH	6.4 to 8.2	6 & below / 9 & above

! Important:

If any of your results fall into the “Not Safe” range, we recommend having your water professionally tested by an accredited laboratory, as it may pose a potential health risk.
